

## 13,500 Acres of Crown Land Islands Protected in Rainy Lake

Members of the Rainy Lake Conservancy helped to preserve 5,477 hectares (13,528 acres) of crown land on the islands of Rainy Lake as conservation reserves. For generations to come, the wild beauty of these islands can be enjoyed by the public through activities such as picnicking, swimming, bird watching, hiking, hunting, photography, and berry picking. As conservation reserves, they cannot be sold, mined, logged or developed.
